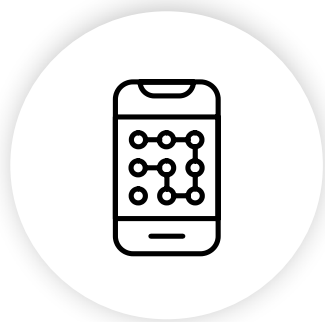


Why Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) is a must

It requires two or more pieces of proof to confirm your identity:

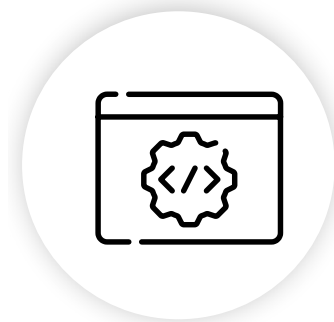


A code sent to your phone
